January 10, 2014. A chest x-ray had revealed a mass that was basically the size of Paige's rib cage. The official diagnosis... T-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia.

In Aug. 2014, Paige was in remission! Although she was still receiving intense chemo treatments, she was looking forward to when she would enter the maintenance phase, returning to school while receiving two years of less intense treatment. So she thought.

In Sept. 2015, just nine months away from

completing treatment, the cancer returned. She is currently awaiting an early December Bone Marrow Transplant. Mom is out of work to care for Paige full-time. Paige's dad, Boyce, and 12-year-old brother, Jeremy, do everything they can while Paige battles this horrid fight. Blood transfusions, sickness from chemo, losing her hair, unplanned hospital stays, and even a fractured leg hasn't kept her down. She exhibits strength and maturity well beyond her now 15 years and shares what God has done in her life with anyone who will listen.
