Oct 19th 2014, The McChristian family was told their little one, 18-month-old Radley, had cancer; words a parent never wants to hear. Diagnosed with Leukemia (AML-M7), the chemo treatments immediately began. They were told that the survival rate for this type of leukemia in children was on 10-30%. The following February, Radley received his first stem cell transplant. Although he did well for a while, the cancer has never fully gone away.

Radley has endured countless rounds of chemo and multiple bone marrow transplants within the past year. Nothing short of a miracle, only 1-5% of the cancer cells still remain. They are hoping

the next batch of stem cells will be available soon and Radley will BEAT this thing!

He's a little "heart stealer", a lady charmer and best friends with everyone he meets. He's extremely smart and seems to have an "all knowing" old soul. He amazes his parents every day. He is their rock and the heart of their little family.
