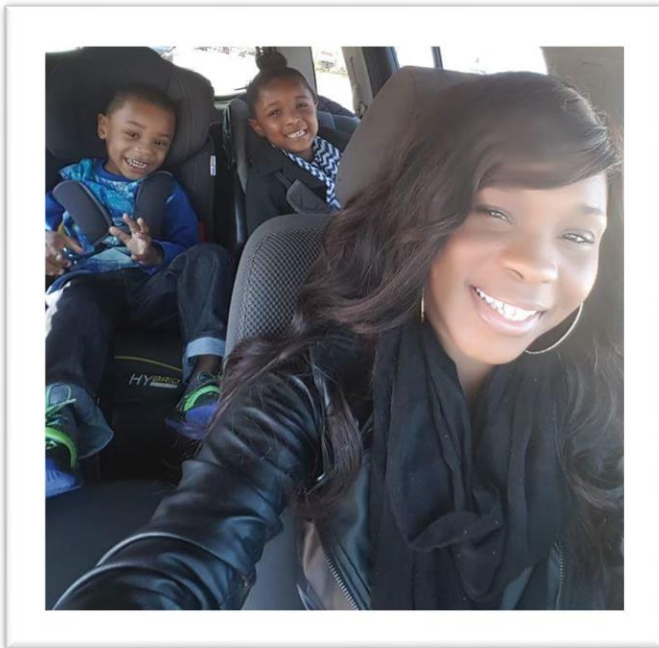

Battling: 25-year-old, Cecily

Imagine being a 25-year-old single mother of two while battling stage 3 colon cancer. That's what Cecily Chandler is currently facing. Being forced to leave her job due to the demands of her illness, Cecily now works as a care giver to her elderly neighbors to make just the minimal ends meet for her and her two little ones, Savannah (age 6) and Caden (age 4).

On April 2, 2015, just two weeks before her 24th birthday, Cecily was diagnosed with colon

cancer. In March 2016 she had gone into remission and thought she had beaten it. However, in June 2016 it had returned with an additional tumor and advanced stage. Her treatment options are limited due to lack of insurance, income and the struggle to provide basic needs for her and her children. Cecily currently pays \$350 per week for her prescriptions to treat her cancer. Her mother (age 67) helps Cecily with childcare despite her own health and financial needs.

Although her struggle is a hard one, Cecily continues to trust that God will bring her through this.
