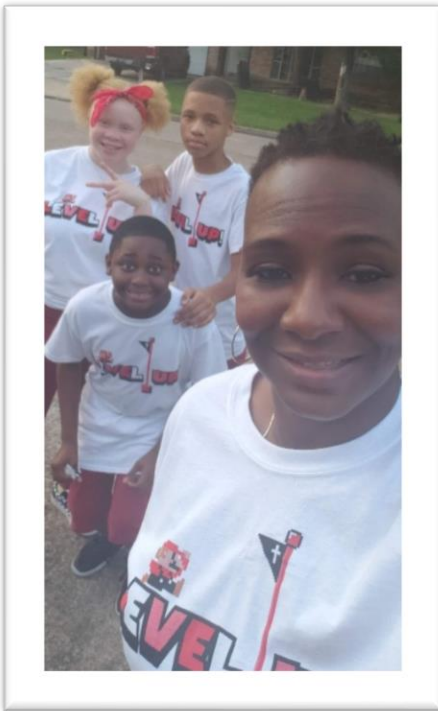

Battling: 11-year-old, Corinthian Giles

It takes a special person to assume the mom role to three kiddos, but Aunt LaTonya did just that in August of 2007. Nine years later, the youngest, Corinthian, was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia at just 9 years of age. To make matters worse, three months after that, LaTonya herself was diagnosed with breast cancer.

Luckily, Corinthian is on what is called the maintenance phase of his treatment. He goes into the hospital twice a month to do labs and speak with his doctor about his progress. Once per month he receives chemo through an IV and he's able to take an oral chemo for his other treatments. Every other month he receives a lumbar puncture to withdraw cells from his spine. Currently, they

expect him to remain on this schedule for another two years. This journey is hard enough but not having his biological mother consistently in his life is an added struggle he faces daily.

Operating as a single-mom, their household runs on a limited income and has been strained since LaTonya was diagnosed in August 2016. The little income they have coming in goes towards necessities and treatments. This year, through the Jamie's Hope program, they won't have to worry about Christmas, so they can worry less about money and more about quality time.
