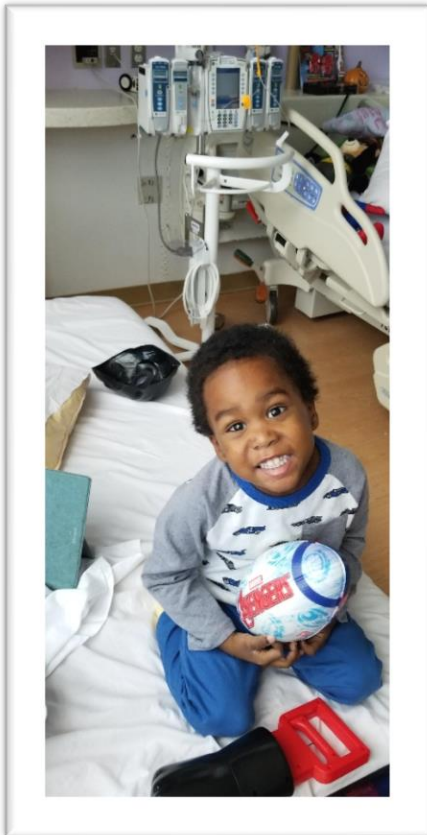

Battling: 3-year-old, Zayn Traylor

September 29, 2018; a date the Traylor family will never forget. 3-year-old, Zayn, had a bloody nose followed by spots on his lips and was running a relentless fever that wouldn't break. After a trip to urgent care, the doctor told them he had a virus that would just need to run its course. Around 11pm that night, mom went to check his fever and noticed blood on his pillow; it was coming from his mouth. Unable to find the source, they took him straight to the emergency room. That's where they heard the "C" word and were transferred to the main campus of the Texas Children's Hospital. The next day, Zayn was diagnosed with Acute Promyelocytic Leukemia and immediately started chemo.

Sixteen days into treatment, Zayn had to be moved to ICU and spent a total of 33 days in the hospital. This little fighter underwent two bone marrow biopsies and multiple platelet and blood transfusions. Currently, for the next nine months,

Zayn will receive four cycles of chemo. His treatment consists of "four weeks on, two weeks off" of daily chemo treatments, Monday – Friday during his "on" weeks. Luckily, mom's job has allowed her the flexibility to work from her laptop at the hospital. Dad on the other hand, cannot and has had to take a significant amount of unpaid leave from work.

This little family of five is battling for their "high spirited" little one. Zayn's 7-year-old sister and 10-year-old brother help keep the smiles on little man's face. This Christmas, we want to help do the same.
