Battling: 11-month-old, Laila



Cancer has stolen more than health from the Wilson family. Since little Laila Wilson was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia in September, the family has been struggling to make ends meet. Laila and her mother, Bianca, only get to spend about five days at home during the month. Laila's siblings, Lacey (6) and Larsen (4), spend most nights away from home with their grandparents or one of their aunts.

Laila's father, Dennis, is the only one in the family that can work right now since Bianca had to leave her job to take care of Laila. But the family has hope.

They have started round three of chemotherapy and in December will be transferring to Texas Children's Hospital in preparation for a bone marrow transplant.

Although the doctors say there's only a 20% chance of finding a donor and then, if it takes, a 20% chance of a relapse, the family has strong faith.

In the meantime, bills are stacking up. Being apart and trying to afford everything has been a struggle. They are hoping that this year they can have a great Christmas together as a family.
