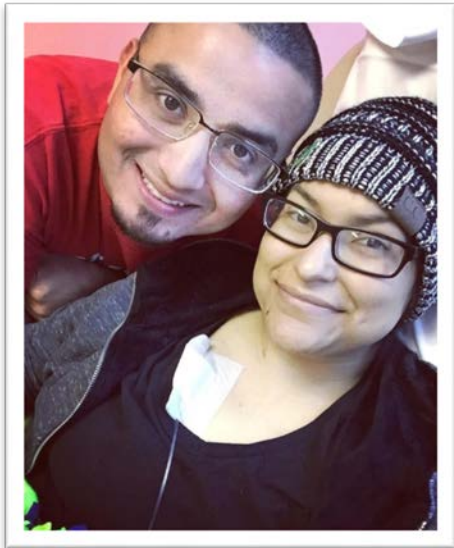

Battling: 26-years-old, Danielle

Danielle and her husband, Eric, have two beautiful children, Addy (age 4) and EJ (age 3) who light up their lives. Taking care of two little ones is hard enough, let alone while battling cancer.

Danielle was first diagnosed with stage 3 intrahepatic cholangiocarcinoma (liver cancer) at the young age of 24. At the time she had no medical insurance and still has a large amount of debt on her shoulders.

Danielle faced aggressive chemo and radiation with many hospital stays, blood transfusions, meds and shots. In the end she felt it was worth it because she went into remission. But her celebration didn't last long. Just two months later she had relapsed. This time it was more advanced and had metastasized.

She's now undergoing a new chemo and radiation will follow. The chemo she's on now is awful. The side effects hit her body so hard, she can hardly keep up. This battle is far worse than the first time and her journey isn't close to being over. With so very few survivors of her particular cancer, Danielle is left with little hope and the financial stress doesn't help. The enormous amount of debt hanging over their heads is disheartening.



"We hope one day, by the grace and mercy of God, I will be healed but until then, I will fight the good fight until He calls me home." Danielle says.
