Battling: 4-year-old, DeOndre

DeOndre and his 1-year-old brother, Chance are cared for by their 23-year-old, single mom, Brittney.

DeOndre, was hospitalized for several weeks in November of 2018. Brittney and her newborn Chance, stayed at the hospital with him for that time until December 4th, 2018 when he was diagnosed with ALL Leukemia. DeOndre was put on a treatment plan and due to complications has had to learn how to walk all over again. Less than a month after diagnosis and being discharged from the hospital, he was admitted to the ICU for High Blood Pressure. Now, at only 3-

years-old, DeOndre is prescribed blood pressure medicine. In addition to chemo and routine lumbar punctures, DeOndre suffers with frequent aches in his bones.

Brittney has had to leave work in order to be there for DeOndre through this time. Even with her many attempts to try finding a way to work, she has had a difficult time finding a job that would work with the demanding hospital schedule for DeOndre's treatments. It is even more difficult for them as they live 1.5 hours from the medical center where he receives treatment. Commuting to the hospital, costs to go to appointments and lack of income, have impacted appointments causing delays in his treatment schedule throughout this journey.

Brittney is very thankful for the support and help that has come along the way and understands that every little bit helps. Brittney's prayer is that this journey will soon be over.
